1. PreK Programming Changes for 2021-22

Mr. Brewster explained that District 2 is now eligible to receive payment vouchers from the state for eligible students. This has been a goal to increase the number of PreK seats, improve the quality of the resources, and the program PreK program overall. This will require our preschool program to change from teaching four (4) days per week with planning and preparation occurring one (1) day per week to teaching five (5) days per week.
