Discuss & Consider <u>Spring Learning Loss Plan</u>, <u>Summer School 2021 Plan</u>, & 2021-22 Return to School Plan Spring Learning Loss Plan - Elementary, Middle School are doing an intervention by inviting students to attend an extra hour each day (Monday - Thursday) with bus transportation being provided.

Summer School Plan - Mr. Brewster along with the YMCA, United Way, and Kiwanis are working together to offer Summer Camp for 11 weeks. These are 100% scholarships, no cost for students. Transportation will be provided, work on academic skill development with certified teachers and assistants. The targeted grade level is K-3. This will be held at the Scott County YMCA.

The Middle School will host 2 summer school sessions for 4 weeks, 5 days per week, 3 hours per day. The academic subjects being covered will be math, language arts, success skills, as well as fun activities.

The High School will have summer school from July 14 - August 3rd. Classes will be offered based on failure data, course requests, and graduation requirements.

Return to school plan - 2021-22. Dr. Slaton said that the district's goal for next school year is to return to the buildings for in person learning. There are currently 339 district wide students who are virtual which is down considerably. This is still a fluid situation that could change however, Dr. Slaton said that the Administration will be working on a plan together to get everyone back in the building for the 2021-22 school year.

## Discuss & Consider PreK Expansion to VFES

Principal Mrs. Copple would like permission to consider adding a preschool at Vienna Finley Elementary starting next school year. She has had conversations with her staff regarding how to make room for the program and everyone agrees and supports this. Mrs. Copple knows the need to reach out to younger children in order to help them succeed academically.

Mr Zollman made a motion to approve. Second by Mrs. Soloe, motion carried 5-0.

The board thanked the Scottsburg Elementary staff that attended the meeting and told them how much they appreciated their dedication to the students.
