# Minutes Board Work Session April 29, 2021

### Board Work Session 5:30 p.m.

   Mrs. Craig called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mrs. Jaime Toppe spoke in favor of an auditorium stating that the Scott County Community Foundation had conducted a Community Assessment along with Dr. Fry from IUS. After this assessment was completed, the majority of the community spoke in support of a performance and visual arts program at Scott District 2. Jaime also noted that studies have shown that performing arts increase test scores. She wanted the board to know that the Community Foundation would help in any way they could to promote this.

Kimberly Tillson also spoke in favor of building an auditorium. She feels that band, choir, and drama help students with their self esteem and she is very impressed with our program and would like to see it continue to grow. She stated that the Band Parents would be glad to help with this project.

Dr. Slaton and the board spoke stating that they were very proud of all the students in the band, choir, and drama club and all of their performances were always amazing and everyone in our community had nothing but wonderful things to say. They feel that a new auditorium is very deserving for those programs and will continue to pursue this in the future. The board asked Dr. Slaton to check with surrounding schools to see what their policies are regarding what their max expenditures are prior to needing board approval.
