Dr. Slaton asked to add to the modified agenda for a discussion and decision to go over what we do to support our teachers, students, community, and our staff as a whole. There will be a per building approach that will be monitored for a short period of time (till October 28th) to see how things are working. This will allow us to address any needed changes. Johnson and Vienna Finley Elementary will be modifying their schedule to accommodate teachers' larger time periods to

address their needs for students both virtually and in-person. Therefore, these two elementary schools will have their students attend 5 days per week. Scottsburg and Lexington Elementary along with the middle school and high school will be piloted by doing a virtual Wednesday for all students. Bus drivers will run their regular routes daily and this will allow parents that need childcare to go ahead and send their student to school on virtual Wednesday's where they will be monitored and work in small groups. Support staff will be in place to help students and teachers on these days. Parents will be receiving a message from their building principal by tomorrow and this change will begin Wednesday, September 23rd. If parents have questions they were directed to use Parent Square. A parent survey will be going out to see who has childcare in place or needs to send their child to school on the virtual day.

Mrs. Roberts clarified that this is a short term solution for now. Dr. Slaton said this would be closely monitored and tweaked and depending on what was working, could help develop a longer term solution for the school year.
