A huge shout out to Pam Akemon , Emily Jordan and Charity Williams along with their staff for making this entire pilot program a success. The district may now start receiving "On My Pre-K funding" for the 4 Year Olds Room and CCDF voucher funding for the 3 Year Old Room.
